Approximately 1 hour 45 minutes' drive towards the State of Pahang. First, a stop at an aborigine settlement to have an insight of the aborigine culture of Malaysia. After that we will proceed to Kuala Gandah Elephant Sanctuary. This conservation centre is run by The Department of Wildlife and National Parks. The department's main task is locating, subduing and then translocating elephants from areas where their habitats have been destroyed due to development and urbanization. The centre strives to highlight the plights of elephants and educate the public about the importance of habitat and environmental preservation.

Over the past 25 years, the centre has helped in preventing further decline of elephant population by relocating more than 300 wild elephants. Tour includes elephant show, elephant feeding and for the brave, a water activity of bathing with the baby elephants in the river.
